2018 RULES CAMPERS AND PARENTS NEED TO KNOW:

- 1. Campus regulations prohibit the use of alcohol and other illegal substances. Campers may not possess, use, distribute, or sell alcoholic beverages, drugs, firearms, weapons or fireworks.
